

MICS July 20 2020 Board "retreat"/work session - no official board business conducted

- I. 19-20 in review: Academics were looking strong (before final testing and review shut down by quarantine), financials remained strong in spite of no increase in per-student state funding, and remote learning and efforts to keep Raptor traditions intact March-May were both exceptional. Staff and family survey results reviewed as part of 19-20 review.
