

Paint Your Spot Fundraiser

We are offering seniors the opportunity to paint their own parking spot. Yes, this means you would have your own parking spot for the entire school year customized by you.

How it works

On the high school website, there is a form (Paint Your Spot Registration Form) that you will need to fill out to allow you to paint your parking spot. You must return this completed form to the high school office no later than September 25th. If you are painting, you will need to pay the \$25 fee at this time. Only seniors who have a painted spot will have an assigned parking space.

The Details

You may paint your spot any day after 4:00 P.M. and when there are no vehicles near your space. Please adhere to the social distancing guidelines during this activity. The senior student spaces are in the North Lot, in the row to the left as you enter the lot and the portion facing the football field. There are two basic objectives for this fundraiser - to raise funds for student activities and to allow seniors to express themselves through school spirit.

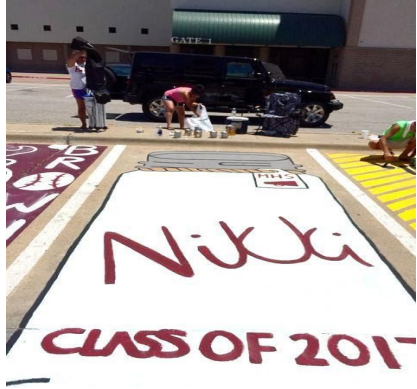
SENIOR PARKING LOT PAINTING RULES

Use a template to chalk in your paint area and create a 12 inch border from all white lines and 12 inches above your parking spot number. Paint with any household interior or exterior paint. Latex paint works the best. NO SPRAY PAINT IS TO BE USED!

As you are creating your template for your parking spot, please be sure the painting is:

- Not offensive in any way to anyone (i.e no profanity, no suggestive content)
- Promoting school pride
- A reflection of your character


