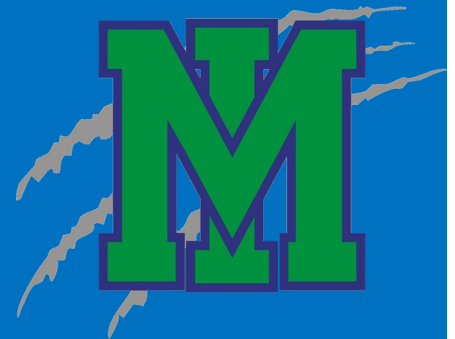

General Campus Information

No Parents/Visitors will be allowed on campus during the school day per current restrictions.



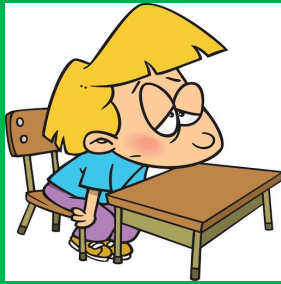
Masks will be required in all settings while on campus. Masks can be taken off to eat, drink and for strenuous outdoor exercise only.

We implement physical distancing where possible; although, we can not guarantee six feet distance at all times. Signs and markings around campus will serve as a reminder to maintain physical distancing.



No large gatherings/assemblies will be allowed on campus until further notice.

General Campus Information



Screen your students every day before school. If a student shows signs of illness. A parent or guardian will be expected to promptly pick them up when notified. Please stay home when you are sick.

Health screenings and temperature checks occur for everyone each day upon arrival. When arriving at school, all students will be screened prior to leaving their car. Students cannot leave their car until they have passed the health screening process. Parents are not allowed to drop off students without being screened.. High school student drivers will park in the high school lot and enter through the C building 2nd floor entrance.



Students and staff must stay home if:

- They have tested positive for COVID-19 and have not met the criteria for returning to school.
- They have recently had close contact with a person with COVID-19 and have not met the criteria for returning to school.
- They have a temperature of 100.4°F or higher.
