

2017-2018 MICS Student Parking Application and Vehicle Registration
(Forms received after the August 16 deadline will be processed within five business days.)

-Parking permits are assigned on a first come, first served basis, giving priority to seniors, then juniors, then sophomores.
 -Parking space is limited, and as such, all students who qualify cannot be guaranteed a space. Students wishing to park on school grounds should submit their completed applications in a timely manner.
 -Parking by students on the campus of Mountain Island Charter School is a privilege, not a right; and in consideration thereof, students must abide by the following requirements and procedures:

Eligibility Requirements

- Student must be a licensed, driving sophomore, junior or senior (Please include a **copy of NC license** with the application.).
- Student must have passed at least five courses in the previous semester and must meet MICS promotion standards.
- Student must have no outstanding school financial obligations.
- Student must not have been suspended (ISS or OSS) during the previously completed semester or the current semester.
- Student must purchase a parking permit for **\$25 (Do not turn in money until you purchase your permit.)**. The cost will be prorated according to the time remaining in the school year. Parking permits are non-transferable. *Student must not attempt to purchase a parking permit for another student. A student who purchases or attempts to purchase a permit for another student will have his/her permit revoked and face disciplinary action.*
- Student must maintain eligibility requirements throughout the school year or the parking permit may be rescinded.

Parking and Driving Procedures

- Student must obey local and state motor vehicle laws, including wearing a seat belt when operating or riding in a vehicle.
- Student must hang the registered school parking permit from the rearview mirror.
- Student must not exceed 10 mph while driving on campus.
- Student must park only in designated areas (Students walking to and from the athletic field parking lot must use the steps.)
- Student must not visit his/her vehicle during school hours without permission and a staff escort from the school office.

Recommended Discipline Responses

-The consequences below are in addition to any consequences outlined in the discipline plan.
 -The consequences are recommended consequences, and they may be adjusted after considering the student and the situation, including the age of the student, the severity of the infraction, the frequency of the infraction, the student's disability, and/or the student's discipline history from the current school year and previous school years.

Procedural Infractions

- First infraction: Formal warning
- Second infraction: Loss of parking privileges for one week
- Third infraction: Loss of parking privileges for one month
- Fourth infraction: Loss of parking privileges for the remainder of the school year
- *Student acknowledges his/her understanding that driving and parking on campus without a valid student parking permit or parking in a manner that impedes normal traffic flow may result in the vehicle being towed at the owner's expense.*
- *Student acknowledges his/her understanding that any action that endangers others may result in revocation of parking permit for the remainder of the school year.*

Other Infractions

- Student agrees that he/she will not leave campus without permission. Leaving campus without permission will result in revocation of parking permit for the remainder of the school year.
- Student agrees that he /she will not bring onto school grounds any items not otherwise allowed on campus. Student acknowledges his/her understanding that school authorities have the right to open, enter, and search his/her vehicle and remove any unauthorized articles, or any other articles that may endanger health, welfare, or safety of students and school personnel. Any such articles may be retained and used as evidence in disciplinary proceedings by school leadership, or delivered to appropriate law enforcement officials at the sole discretion of the school leadership. Having any such items found in the student's vehicle may result in revocation of parking permit for the remainder of the school year.
- Student acknowledges his/her understanding that any other discipline infractions, including those not related to driving on campus, that result in suspension may also result in revocation of parking permit for the remainder of the school year.
