- VI. <u>Sub-Committee Reports:</u>
 - a. Academics: no update
 - b. Finance/Facilities:
 - i. The MICS, Inc. financial audit for the financial year ending June 20, 2020, was performed by Potter & Company and reported no material issues.
 - ii. The MICS SOAR Foundation audit was performed by a different auditor, C Dewitt Foard, but the audit results were provided to Potter & Company to include in their report since SOARs financials represent 31% of MICS, Inc.'s net position. The SOAR audit was also clean and contained no material issues.
 - iii. The scope of these audits includes reviewing financial statements, financial reporting, and any internal controls to ensure accounting practices and financial reporting practices adhere to state set standards.
 - iv. If anyone is interested, the full audit report can be supplied via email.
 - c. <u>Governance:</u>
 - i. Moratorium instituted at last board meeting on leasing MICS facilities until Jan 11th board meeting, however Governance proposes to restrict on-campus activities for the majority of in-school activities for all lessees in order to give Governance time to write a complete policy.
 - ii. Based on feedback from the Board members, motion to keep moratorium until further review. Greg motion, Kevin 2nd, Brett opposed, remaining in favor- motion approved.

 - e. <u>SOAR Report:</u> Met Wednesday, 1/6 at 6:30pm.
 - i. Due to COVID, all in-person activities/events are on hold.
 - ii. Committee is looking into a virtual "silent" Auction, a virtual Sweetheart Dance (daddy/daughter, mom/son, etc.), and what can we do for our teachers/staff/students to support them in these crazy times now is the time to spend money to support the school and school community.

- A. <u>School Remote Learning Transition Update:</u>
 - 1. Motion to approve remote learning transition, Kevin motion, Todd 2nd, all in favor, approved.
 - 2. Decision matrix/timing on learning environment changes
 - a) During the initial survey most of the staff were in favor of a 2-week delay in starting school in-person.
 - b) School will put a survey out later this week on staff perspective on returning to school.
 - c) Looking at a combination three factors on decision to come back:
 - (1) Inside school cases (COVID positive cases on students and staff confirmed through Dept of health and through parent information sent to school).
 - (2) Community case trends (Gaston and Mecklenburg counties)
 - (3) Measure capacity of internal teams to deliver the program
 - d) Final decision by COB Wednesday or Thur.
